

October 12, 2022 CGG Webinar Announcement: "De-globalization? China, Inc. on the World Stage"

The ongoing lockdowns in cities around China underscored for many Chinese that "living and working [in China] is not a right, but a privilege granted by the party". Has the triumph of politics over economics finally been consolidated in the corporate party-state that is contemporary China?

Join us on October 12 as Prof. Shaomin Li of Old Dominion University and others discuss his new book, *The Rise of China, Inc.* in the context of current global challenges. After hosting the Winter Olympics, and with the backdrop of the imminent 20th Party Congress of the CCP, China is holding on to an enviable position as the ascendant power of the 21st Century. It remains to be seen what paths other countries will choose in negotiating their relationships with China and its ruling Party.

Was China's success in globalization enabled by the willing blindness of Western participants in conjunction with a wily Chinese Communist Party taking advantage of cultural and historical traditions? What are some of the implications for foreign companies and policy makers of China's integration of state, society and business?
